

ORDINANCE 7-20-09(2009)

Class A Alcohol Beverages Licenses

The Town Board of Farmington does ordain as follows:

A. Definitions:

1. A Class "A" fermented malt beverage license authorizes retail sales of beverages for consumption off the premises where sold and in original packages, container and bottles.
2. A "Class A" intoxicating liquor license authorizes retail sales of beverages for consumption off the premises where sold and in original packages and containers.

B. Fees:

1. Fermented Malt Beverages – Class "A" Retailer License - \$100.00
2. Intoxicating Liquor – "Class A" Retailer License - \$300.00

C. Closing Hours:

1. Class "A" beer: 9 p.m. to 8 a.m.
2. "Class A" liquor: 9 p.m. to 8 a.m.

D. Quota: The number of Class "A" fermented malt beverage and "Class A" intoxicating liquor licenses that will be issued will be limited to one for every 500 of population as determined by the last federal decennial census, or such lesser number as the town board in its discretion sees fit to authorize and issue.

E. Other Restrictions: In addition to all other provisions of Chapter 125, Wisconsin Statutes – Alcohol Beverages, the following restrictions apply:

1. No Class "A" or "Class A" license shall be issued for any premises where any other business is conducted in connection with the premises, except that this restriction does not prohibit the issuance of a license to a convenience store, retail grocery store, or a combination liquor/cheese store.

F. The purpose of this ordinance is to limit the number of Class A licensed premises in the Town of Farmington, to encourage adherence to alcohol beverages regulations, and to facilitate the enforcement of laws relating to the sale and consumption of alcoholic beverages. If any provision of this ordinance is declared invalid; all other provisions shall remain in full force and effect.

G. This ordinance shall take effect the day after its publication, pursuant to Sec. 60.80, Wisconsin Statute.
