

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, a portion of lots 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, and 8 of the plat of "Indian Hill Park" located in Sec. 33, T 22N, R 11E, Town of Farmington, Waupaca County, Wisconsin encroach upon the road right-of-way known as Cleghorn Road, and,

WHEREAS, certain dwellings upon said lots encroach upon said Cleghorn Road, and,

WHEREAS, the Town Board of Farmington, Waupaca County, Wisconsin is satisfied that said encroachments have existed since the dwellings were constructed, and,

WHEREAS, the present Town Board of Farmington does not intend to relocate or otherwise disturb said Cleghorn Road as it presently exists, NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the present Town Board of Farmington, Waupaca County, Wisconsin that it is the policy of the Town Board to keep the aforesaid Cleghorn Road at its present location and not to require the relocation of the dwellings from the encroached-upon portions.
